BIO FACT SHEET

Scott Fletcher . . . a 15-year veteran of **Major League Baseball**, Scott was born in Fort Walton, FL, on July 30, 1958. Scott was first drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers on June 8, 1976, but did not sign due to his plans to attend college . . . He was also drafted on January 10, 1978, by the Oakland Athletics & on June 6, 1978, by the Houston Astros, and again held off from signing . . . Scott finally signed as the 1st Round Draft pick, 6th overall, of the Chicago Cubs in 1979 and had his MLB debut on April 25, 1981 with the Cubs . . .

After 2 years, he was acquired by the White Sox where he played for 3 seasons . . . His next team was the Texas Rangers where he played for 3½ seasons before returning to the White Sox in 1989 in a trade that brought both Scott & Sammy Sosa to the White Sox . . . Scott played his 1992 season with the Milwaukee Brewers, then in 1993 & 1994 in Boston with the Red Sox . . . Scott completed his MLB career on September 29, 1995 with the Detroit Tigers . . . During this 15-year span Scott played every infield position, but specialized as a Shortstop, 839 games, & as a 2nd Baseman, 729 games . . .

Scott has a career Fielding Percentage of .980, a career Batting Average of .262 and a career Slugging Percentage of .342. Scott recorded his career high season Batting Average as a Texas Ranger when he hit .300 for the season in 1986 & had a career high Slugging Percentage of .402 in 1993 with the Boston Red Sox . . . In his final season with the Tigers he accomplished the "perfect season" as an infielder with no errors in his 68 games . . . Scott now helps others to "pursue the dream" of becoming a MLB player through his organization of **Fletcher Baseball** . . . Scott's hobbies include Golf & working with youth of all ages through Baseball Clinics, Camps & **Fletcher Baseball** events.
